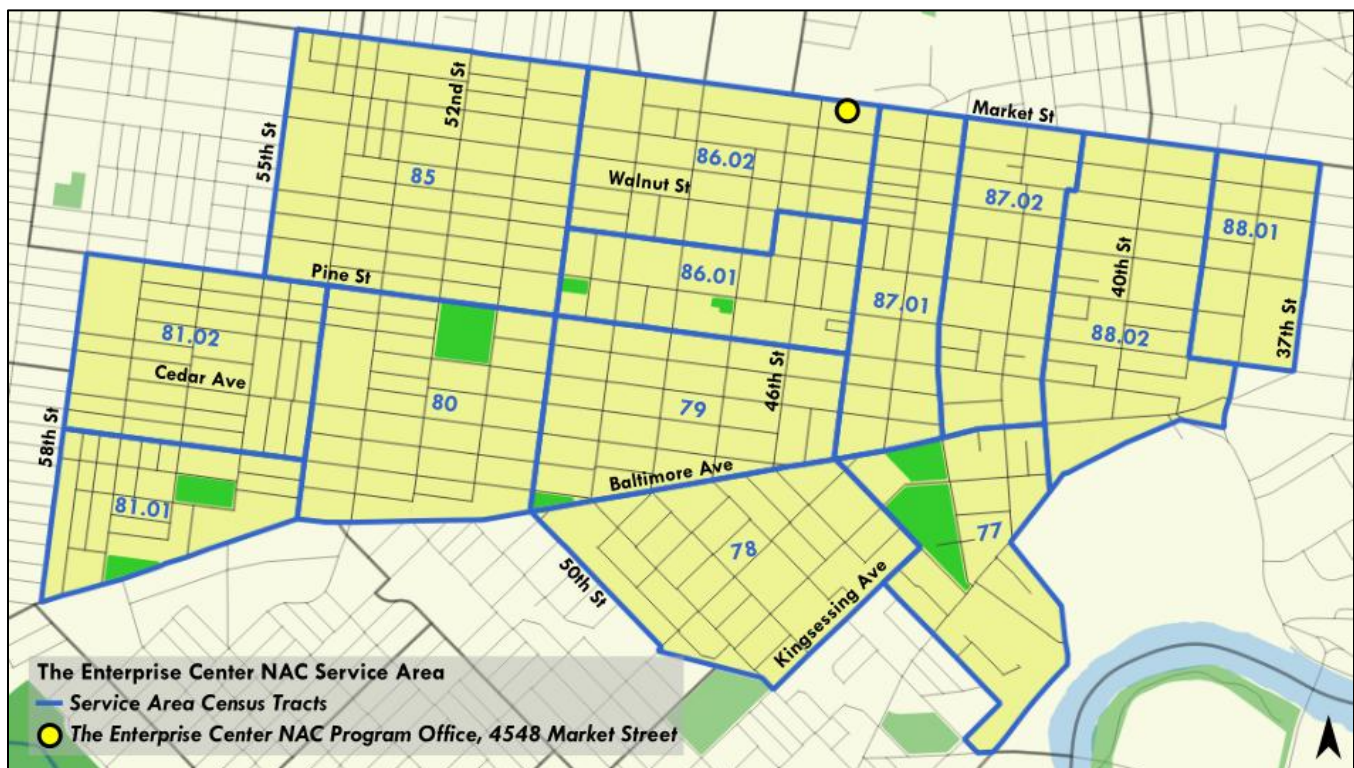


## The Enterprise Center Community Development Corporation Neighborhood Advisory Committee (NAC)

Beginning in October 2015, The Enterprise Center CDC administers a Neighborhood Advisory Committee (NAC) that serves the West Philadelphia neighborhoods of Cedar Park, Garden Court, Spruce Hill, Walnut Hill, and parts of Cobbs Creek and University City. The aim of the NAC program is to help connect residents to city services and resources, and to help neighborhoods solve problems and have a voice in community development issues.



The NAC program is funded by the City of Philadelphia Office of Housing and Community Development, which designates service areas by census tracts. The NAC program places a particular emphasis on assisting low- to-moderate income residents, with a focus on:

- Connecting residents to a variety of housing and home repair resources
- Helping communities address blight and development issues
- Disseminating timely information to residents about resources and services
- Communicating resident feedback to city officials

The Enterprise Center CDC NAC Manager serves as a liaison between service area residents and the city and assists residents in accessing resources and achieving community goals.
